

**Re: application by The Ontario Educational Communications Authority (OECA) to renew the English-language educational television service, TVO**

The Canadian Radio-television and telecommunications Commission, the public authority which regulates and supervises the Canadian broadcasting system, has received an application by the Ontario Educational Communications Authority to renew the broadcasting licence of this station, operating under the name TVO with the call letters CICA-TV in Toronto, and associated transmitters throughout the province. The current licence expires on August 31, 2008.

The licensee proposes to operate TVO under the same terms and conditions as specified in the current licence.
